If you answer yes to any of the following on the Risk Assessment, you must also complete a Medical Questionnaire:

- I am not working with or handling laboratory animals, but will be accessing areas where laboratory animals are housed. (Includes IACUC members and facilities personnel.)
- I will be working with laboratory animals.
- I will be working with laboratory animals and I am working with human specimens (cells, body fluids, etc.) in conjunction with animal studies.
- I will be working with laboratory animals and I am working with microbes (such as viral vectors and/or bacteria) in conjunction with animal studies.
- I am involved in veterinary care or animal husbandry.

Submit Medical Questionnaire

You must complete the Medical Questionnaire in order to obtain clearance to work with animals and have access to the animal facilities. Failure to obtain medical clearance may result in delayed access to the animals, revocation of your privilege to work with animals, and may jeopardize Caltech's NIH funding, accreditation and/or federal assurance to work with animals in research.

Do not complete the Medical Questionnaire if you are named on an IACUC protocol but will not be working with live animals.

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
