



Caltech BBP/ATD Vaccination Declination Statement

In accordance with the OSHA-Cal/OSHA Title 8/5193 Bloodborne Pathogens Standard and the OSHA-Cal/OSHA Title 8/5199 Aerosol Transmissible Diseases Standard, certain occupations at Caltech pose an increased risk of exposure to infectious diseases, some of which are preventable upon vaccination.

The vaccinations below are made available free of charge to qualifying Caltech employees.

I understand that due to my occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens and aerosol transmissible diseases, I may be at risk of acquiring infection with Hepatitis B Virus, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis, and/or Varicella-Zoster Virus. I have been given the opportunity to be vaccinated against these diseases or pathogens at no charge to me.

At this time, I decline the following vaccination(s):

- Hepatitis B Virus
- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Acellular Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella-Zoster Virus

I decline the vaccine(s) because I already received them, and I am up to date on my immunization schedule. Or I understand that by declining this vaccine(s), I continue to be at risk of acquiring the associated serious disease(s). If in the future I continue to have occupational exposure to bloodborne pathogens and aerosol transmissible diseases and want to be vaccinated, I can receive the vaccination at no charge to me.
